Africa's Business Heroes (ABH) aims to identify, support, and inspire the next generation of African entrepreneurs who are making an impact in their local communities, working to solve the most pressing problems, and building a more sustainable and inclusive economy for the future.

Every year, ten finalists are selected to compete in the ABH grand finale pitch competition for a share of USD 1.5 million in grant money. All finalists also join an exclusive community of like minded entrepreneurs, business professionals, investors and mentors. In addition, they get access to training and networking opportunities to further support them on their business journey.

ABOUT THE AFRICA'S BUSINESS HEROES SUMMIT

The first day (Thursday, 23rd November) will be a gathering of entrepreneurs, investors, and the broader ecosystem players under the theme of "**AI: African Innovation, Insight, and Impact**". The summit will consist of talks and workshops carefully curated to add value to entrepreneurs and professionals at various stages of their journey. Below are some formats in which the first day conversations will occur.

- **TED style talks:** Short, powerful talks that spark curiosity from some of our heavy-weight speakers.
- Live Podcasts: In-depth discussions and interviews with entrepreneurs on the various lessons they have gathered as they built and scaled their businesses.
- **Debate:** Thought-provoking conversations and debates on critical topics.
- **Interactive Workshops:** Well- curated and educational workshops with topics that are relevant for entrepreneurs and professionals alike.

ABOUT THE AFRICA'S BUSINESS HEROES GRAND FINALE PITCH COMPETITION


The second day (Friday, 24th November) will feature the Grand Finale Pitch Competition, where our 2023 Top 10 Heroes will take the stage to pitch for their share of \$1.5 million! This year, we received over 27,000 applications from all 54 African countries, a record-high number since the beginning of ABH and our Top 10 finalists have been through a rigorous selection process that spanned 7 months.

We worked with about 400 hundred judges in 3 different rounds to obtain the **Top 10 finalists**. They hail from **9 countries** and represent **6 sectors**, with majority in Healthcare, Agriculture, and Financial Services, and Retail. During this in-person Grand Finale event, our Top 10 will compete for Top 3 prizes (ranging from \$300,000 to \$150,000). All other Heroes will go home with a minimum of 100,000 USD.
